Capacity Fee should be stated on per kW per month not kWh."</p> <p>While in the Annex C of the ITB it states that: "The Generation Rate is set at kilowatt-hour rate (Php/KWh) which covers the costs of all services and cost recoveries involved in power supply provision."</p> <p>This was later on clarified in the latest response of IEC sent last Jan. 26, 2023:</p> <p>"</p> <p>The TPBAC and TWG agrees that :</p> <p>1. The Bidders will use the Average Energy for the whole contract period using the Forecasted Energy Demand declared in ANNEX A of Instruction to Bidders.</p> <p>2. For Simple Calculation:</p> <p>Capacity Fee (Php/kWh) = Rate x Average Forecasted Energy Demand Fixed O&M Fee(Php/kWh)= rate x Average Forecasted Energy Demand Variable O&M Fee (Php/kWh) = VOM x rate x Average Forecasted Energy Demand Raw Material Cost (Php/kWh) = Raw Materials x rate x Average Forecasted Energy Demand "</p> | <p>1.)
